## RED WINES

**47** Pine Ridge Cabernet Sauvignon, *Stag's Leap California* — 120.00

*A lush nose of dark cherry, cassis, blueberry and smoke melds smoothly on the palate. Dark cherry, berry, cocoa and tobacco notes balance.*

**46** Liberty School Cabernet Sauvignon, *Paso Robles California* — 40.00 / 10.75 glass

*Dry, smooth and classic in blackberry and currant flavors, with a deft touch of smoky oak. Unbelievable balance of tannin and acidity.*

**54** William Hill Cabernet Sauvignon, *California Central Coast* — 30.00 / 8.75 glass

*Dark with intense flavor and dramatic fruit presence. Flavors of dark cherry, ripe plum and blueberry are complemented by sweet vanilla and brown spice.*

**44** Chateau de PEZ Grand Vin, *France* — 95.00

*Dark and clean fruit on the nose, with a fresh, stony, perfumed character. There is a nicely supple texture on the palate, with a little richness.*

**43** Lafite Barons de Rothschild Bordeaux, *France* — 92.00

*Dominated by red fruit, the nose remains clear and complex. In the mouth, the strength and classic style becomes apparent.*

**56** Luca Malbec, *Argentina* — 80.00

*Loads of spice and black cherry cola aromas with notes of cocoa. The berry flavors really pop on the palate with good depth and long finish.*

**45** La Posta Malbec, *Argentina* — 42.00 / 11.00 glass

*Intense aromas of red rose petals and red berry fruits fill the nose. Violet, berry and mocha flavors on the palate with a hint of blueberry and chocolate on the finish.*

**58** Argyle Pinot Noir, *Oregon* — 70.00

*Dark fruit aromatics like blackberry and black cherry with nice spicy complexity. Rich and robust flavor. Folds into lovely fresh earth on middle palate.*

**53** Bridlewood Pinot Noir, *California* — 38.00 / 10.50 glass

*Expresses dark fruit flavors of currant, plum and blueberry with nuances of vanilla and brown spice. Well balanced with a round mouthfeel, and a smooth, lingering finish.*

**57** Owen Roe "Ex Umbris" Syrah, *Washington* — 65.00

*Deep plum and dark cherry perfume precedes the velvety texture with bushels of blackberry, peppercorn and black licorice playing against plush tannins.*

**49** Decoy Zinfandel, *Napa California* — 62.00

*The aromas are ripe and lifted, offering layers of strawberry jam, vanilla, sweet oak and white pepper. Finishes with notes of raspberry, cinnamon and nutmeg.*

**42** Cline Ancient Vine Zinfandel, *Sonoma California* — 45.00 / 13.00 glass

*Wonderful strawberry with coffee and chocolate characters. Subtle vanilla quality and a complement of explosive fruit notes.*

**50** Chateau Tanunda Grand Barossa Shiraz, *Australia* — 55.00 / 13.75 glass

*Lifted aromas of blackberry, plum and black pepper are accompanied by spicy, dark berry fruits on the palate.*

**51** Tangle Oaks Merlot, *Napa California* — 45.00 / 11.50 glass

*Lush plum and cherry fruit and undertones of mocha. Medium bodied with a round texture and lingering finish.*

**59** Terre Andina Merlot, *Chile* — 25.00 / 7.50 glass

*Very ripe fruit like plums and black currant flavors complemented by black pepper and grilled red pepper with sweet spice flavors.*

**48** Project Paso Blend, *Paso Robles California* — 40.00 / 10.75 glass

*Intense red cherry followed by white pepper, dark blackberry and blueberry with a light floral character in the background. Balance of eight varietals.*
