SPARKLING / CHAMPAGNE

2 Taittinger, Comtes de Champagne, France — 185.00

Clean fragrance offset by warm, toasty nuances. Generous white fruit flavors underscored by fine, crisp acidity and subtle mineral notes.

4 Perrier Jouet, Fleur de Champagne, France — 175.00

Most famous of this brand, light bodied and distinctive. Aromas of fresh pineapple, white florals and pear.

6 Veuve Clicquot, Yellow Label, France — 125.00

Lovely bouquet of fresh bread dough and vanilla-ripe apple flavors and pecan. Stony undertones with creamy, smoke tinged finish.

8 Mums Cordon Rouge, France — 95.00

Long aging provides flavors of vanilla, roasted nuts and hint of toast. Lightness of chardonnay and fruitiness of pinot noir. A lively, lingering finish.

7 Iron Horse Russian Cuvee, Russian River, California — 65.00

Perfectly balanced point between sweet and dry. Led by warm apple. As creaminess settles in, flavors of pear, subtle lemon and touch of minerality appear.

9 Domaine Brut Rose, Caneros, California — 45.00 / \$10.00 glass

Great balance emphasizing fruity and floral characteristics. Aromas of dried cherry, orange peel, and apple with a cleansing minerality.

10 Cristalino Brut, Spain — 30.00 / \$8.00 glass

Smooth and fresh aromas; fine and fruity on palate with a dry after taste. Clean, dry and crisp.

WHITE WINES

14 Cakebread Chardonnay, California — 80.00

Perfumed aromas of fresh melon, yellow apple, lime and white peach with mineral and toasty-spicy oak scents. Full bodied, yet sleek.

28 A to Z Chardonnay, Oregon — 40.00 / 10.75 glass

Fresh and juicy with concentrated flavors of honey, Granny Smith apples, mandarins and melon. Steely finish with hints of mineral and citrus.

32 William Hill Chardonnay, California Central Coast — 30.00 / 9.00 glass

Flavors of ripe tree fruit and spice with hints of citrus and tropical notes. Vanilla and toasty oak round the palate. Nicely balanced with a concentrated finish.

15 Molly Dooker “The Violinist” Verdelho, Australia — 65.00

A lovely, creamy texture, great acidity and long, persistent flavors of honeysuckle, pineapple and citrus. A lot of body on the palate.

20 Ferreira Albarino, Spain — 62.00

Complex aromas of salinity and exotic fruits with wet earth/herbal tones. Freshness and fruitiness well balanced with crisp acidity.

25 Joseph Drouhin Pouilly-Fuisse, France — 50.00

Among the floral and fruity aromas, almond and ripe grapes dominate. On the palate, the wine is light with a long, refreshing aftertaste.

29 Treana Blend, California Central Coast — 60.00

A bouquet of peaches and lime is bolstered by aromatic notes of honeysuckle. Full in body, rich in flavor. A long finish with dried apricot, pineapple, citrus and honey.

24 Schloss Vollrads Riesling-Kabinett, Germany — 60.00

Aroma of apricots with floral notes; good structure and well balanced acidity.

17 Dr. L Riesling, Germany — 40.00 / 10.50 glass

Luscious pear, peach and apple aromas retain a crisp sweet-tart quality of ripening fruit just before harvest. Simultaneously sweet and tart, dry and mouth-watering.

26 Maso Canali Pinot Grigio, Italy — 48.00 / 11.50 glass

The nose delivers nectarine and light citrus. It is well-balanced with depth on the palate, fresh acidity and a long, clean finish.

27 Crios Torrontes, Argentina — 40.00 / 10.75 glass

Light floral with hints of peach pit and tangerine. Structure and acidity similar to Sauvignon Blanc. Fruity and floral, yet still quite dry.

30 Umberto Fiore Moscato d’Asti, Italy — 35.00 / 10.00 glass

A unique wine with half the carbonation of a typical sparkling wine. Extremely aromatic with a complex perfume. Mild sweetness counterbalanced with vibrant acidity.

31 Walnut Block Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand — 32.00 / 9.25 glass

Wonderful aromas of ripe gooseberry, citrus and honeydew. Extended lees aging has created a rich and finely textured palate with great fruit intensity.
